1. We have been serving Defiance County for **66 years**.
2. United Way of Defiance County funds **26 programs** in Defiance County. View the list of funded programs on our [website](#).
3. **972 children** from birth to age 5 are currently enrolled in Imagination Library. We have graduated 1,100 children from the program and distributed over **62,500 books** since 2009.
4. We fund the Information and Referral 24 hour hotline through A Renewed Mind. DIAL 1-800-468-HELP.

6. We have stuffed over **100,000 bags** of food through Backpack Buddy since we began in 2010.
7. **Feeding Success** food & personal care item pantries are available at all county middle and high schools.
8. We are not government funded. We do fund programs in Defiance County that also receive government funding, and our dollars can bridge gaps and support specific needs of our county and community. Ask us about this.
9. We coordinate over **1,000 hours** of **community service** and award **\$1,000 Youth Volunteer Scholarship** annually through the Community Engagement Center.
